The Marysville Police Department invites you to join our Citizen's Academy! In accordance with our mission to integrate our department with the community, we created the Marysville Police Citizen's Academy. It is our intent to provide citizens with a close look at the department, the officers, and the law enforcement services through interactive classroom activities, demonstrations, and discussion.

Our instructors include members of your Marysville Police Department. We will provide experts in each field from the Chief of Police to the veteran officers who patrol your streets. This program allows for interfacing at a personal level. You are encouraged to ask questions and learn both *what* we do and *why* we do it. It is our hope that the academy experience will be a positive way for our department and community to learn from each other.

You must be 18 years or older at the date of application, and pass a background investigation

This program is not structured like a traditional police academy. There are no push-ups, shined boots, or drill instructors. The academy is scheduled over ten (10) weeks of interaction beginning on May 18th. The final class will be a graduation ceremony at City Hall. Classes begin at 1800 (6:00pm) and end at 2030 (8:30pm). Most classes will be held at the new state-of-the-art Cal-Trans facility in Marysville.
