MARYSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES 2017 CITIZEN'S ACADEMY

Are you ready for the 2017 Marysville Police Department Citizen's Academy! The Citizen's Academy, which began in 2014, is a great example of the Department's mission to partner with the community we serve and is meant to provide citizens with a close look at the department, the officers, and criminal justice system through interactive activities, demonstrations, and discussion.

Instructors include members of your Marysville Police Department, from the Chief of Police to the veteran officers who patrol your streets, as well as criminal justice professions from the region. Academy participants are encouraged to ask questions and learn about *what* we do, *how* we do it and *why* we do it. It is our hope that the academy experience will be a positive way for the department and community to learn from each other.

This program is not structured like a traditional academy. There are no push-ups, shined boots, or drill instructors. The academy is scheduled over 10 weeks of instruction and will be held from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm on Thursday nights, beginning May 18, 2017 and culminating with a graduation on July 25, 2017. Most classes will be held at the new state-of-the-art Caltrans building in Marysville (703 B Street). The Marysville Police Department is currently accepting applications from residents of the Yuba-Sutter region. Applicants must be 18 years or older and pass a brief background investigation. Applications can be dropped off or mailed to the Marysville Police Department at 316 6th Street Marysville, CA 95901. The deadline for applications is May 12, 2017.
