MARYSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT SEIZES 60 POUNDS OF MARIJUANA DURING TRAFFIC STOP

On Saturday, October 17th at approximately 10:30 p.m., a Marysville police sergeant made a traffic stop on a van that was traveling on the wrong side of the roadway. The stop occurred on 9th Street at B Street, near a small shopping center in Marysville. Upon contacting the driver of the van, the sergeant could smell marijuana coming from inside the van. The sergeant also observed in plain view, a large clear plastic bag containing marijuana.

Upon searching the van, officers located 60 pounds of processed and unprocessed marijuana, packaged into several large boxes. Officers seized the marijuana and arrested the driver and passenger for transportation of marijuana. The driver was identified as 71 year old Nhome Saradeth, a Sacramento resident. The passenger was identified as 71 year old Bao Inthabane, a Fresno resident. Both Saradeth and Inthabane were booked into the Yuba County Jail. As of today's date (10-20-2015), neither Saradeth nor Inthabane were in custody at Yuba County Jail.
